# Student & youth jobs



Spend your summer working with our Environmental Services team on the **Rideau Canal** or **Trent-Severn Waterway**.

This rewarding field-based position is open to up to (4) students on the **Trent-Severn Waterway** and (2) students on the **Rideau Canal**.

This position offers a great opportunity to gain experience **monitoring and controlling invasive species** on land and in water, as well as **conducting shoreline assessments** from watercraft.

Other projects include:

- Identifying and protecting **species-at-risk** (ie. turtles, Monarch and Butternut).
- Assisting with **lock stewardship** initiatives (ie. building and distributing turtle nest protectors, maintaining pollinator gardens, collecting wildflower & native grass seeds and participating in BioBlitz events).
- Supporting **vegetation assessments**.
